LUXURY EUROPEAN PERMANENT MAKEUP

Eyeliner Permanent Makeup Aftercare Instructions

Day of The Procedure:

- Do **NOT** touch or wash your eyes. Your eyes may feel tight and swollen, this is normal. Before bed you may take a Benadryl to reduce any swelling.
- For the next 48 hours, blot the eyes every 3 hours with a wet cotton pad to remove all the lymph.
- Apply a clean cloth to the eye to act as a barrier between the eye if you need to ice your eyes. Never apply the ice directly to the eye.
- Apply a thin layer of ointment before bed.

Day 2:

- Avoid touching and washing your eyes on day 2.
- The eyes may be swollen the day after the procedure, this is a normal reaction for clients as some swell more than others. Swelling should start to go down as you start moving around.
- Continue to blot the eyes with a wet cotton pad until the end of your 48hrs.
- Apply a thin layer of ointment before bed.

Day 3-7:

- If the skin feels very dry, tight, or itchy throughout the day, apply a thin layer of ointment.
- Wash your hands and apply the ointment with a Q-tip.
- Apply a thin layer of ointment before bed.

Avoid the following from day 1-7:

- Avoid all water contact for 7 days while you are healing
- Do not wear eye makeup for 1 week
- No saunas/No pools/swimming/ Tanning
- Do **NOT** pick scabs
